
Lodges at the same time. Given the very low membership in some Lodges he mentioned the possibility of becoming a Historic or Occasional Lodge with some restrictions attached.

Mentioning Resolutions, the GM mentioned the 2 carryover Resolutions. That being raising the per-capita by \$10 to cover ever increasing expenses. Also, having the percentage dropped to 67% instead of 90% to make changes to the Code. A resolution committee headed by PGM Mark Marsh is beginning to make fruit so that resolutions can be introduced in the proper form. I must mention that PM Ely had mentioned an idea floated by the GM of members in the process of Degrees but not yet being a Master Mason having to start over when moving to Nevada from other Jurisdictions.
