Members earn awards for their activities they participate in, and scholarships may be available for those seeking higher education.

Members of Rainbow are active in their schools, communities and churches. They raise money for various charities, and they extend themselves in service to their communities and their sponsoring organizations. Many girls go on to become leaders in all fields of employment. IORG has an active membership of 275,000 girls worldwide with over one million majority members. It is represented in 45 states and in nine foreign countries. Girls from Queensland and New South Wales, Australia, Brazil, Bolivia, Aruba, Japan, the Philippine Islands, Canada and Germany enjoy the same privileges of the Order as the girls in the United States. The International Order of the Rainbow for Girls was established in McAlester, Oklahoma in 1922. The guidelines governing the organization and the ritual, were the work of W. Mark Sexson, a 33-degree Mason from McAlester, Oklahoma.
